Annual Report to the Akeley Parish Council - March 2018

The principal events in 2017 were the Annual Pig Roast and Party and Beacon Lighting in celebration of the 70th Anniversary of the wedding of the Queen and Prince Philip.

The latter was arranged to coincide with the Village School PTFA Christmas Fayre. The Beacon was lit by Mrs Ellen Sayer the outgoing Parish Clerk in recognition of her lengthy service to the Parish Council

The Pig Roast was held on Saturday 24th June. Attendance was above that in 2016 years and the event produced a small profit. The Committee is extremely grateful for the hard work of all of the volunteers.

The 2018 event will take place on 23rd June.

At the request of the Parish Council the Events Committee adopted a newly drafted constitution at an AGM in May 2017. The elected officers of the Committee were; Chair, John Norman; Treasurer, Roger Waite; Secretary, Sue Norman. A copy of the constitution was forwarded to the Parish Council.

The Constitution required the setting up of a bank account in the Committee's name. Funds previously held in the Village Hall Account were transferred into the new account
